Position Description; Scope of the role:

The Praise & Rejoice Choir Director is responsible for tending and developing to the already established Praise & Rejoice Choir. They must be able to perform a variety of both traditional and current songs. A visionary and builder that will build upon the current music ministry.

This is a 9 month position (September – May) and will receive a stipend during those months.

The Praise & Rejoice Choir Director will report to the Worship & Music Committee and Senior Pastor.

Main Responsibilities and Duties:

This list is intended to indicate the general nature and level of work to be performed and is not designed to be interpreted as an exhaustive listing of all tasks required of this position.

- Preparing the Choir: Leading rehearsals, warm-ups, and providing guidance
- Selecting Music: Choosing pieces for the choir to perform and selecting anthems for worship services
- Conducting Performances: Governing the choir during performances
- Recruiting: Finding new singers and volunteers
- Administering: Attend committee meetings and work with Worship & Music Committee on scheduling performance dates and communicate with the Business Administrative Assistant

A passion for music and knowledge of a wide variety of musical styles and the ability to teach these varying styles to the choir.
