SCRATCH THE SURFACE

1. We are thinking about the fifth petition of the Lord’s Prayer tonight. What are the petitions we have already covered?

2. The video we watched talked about the difference between, “That’s OK” and “You’re forgiven.” What is the difference? Does the difference matter?

Dig Deeper

1. The fifth petition asks for God’s forgiveness for sins/treaspases. What is sin/trespas?

2. What is forgiveness?

3. When have you forgiven someone for something that they have done? How did it feel to offer forgiveness?

4. When have you been forgiven for something that you did? How did it feel?

5. God is a forgiving God. There are many places in scripture that we encounter God’s forgiveness. Look up the following and talk about what each one says about God and forgiveness.

- c. Mark 11:25
- d. Hebrews 8:12
- e. 1 John 1:9

- 6. Read page 24 in your Small Catechism. The Lord's Prayer: The Fifth Petition on your app.
- 7. God is a God of forgiveness. What is our response to that forgiveness?

Bible Story OF THE WEEK Forgiveness: Matthew 18:21-33

- 1. How often did Jesus tell Peter that you should forgive?
- 2. The parable is about a king and a slave. How much was the debt that the king forgave
- 3. How did the king treat the slave when he couldn't pay?
- 4. The slave then came across another who owed him a far less amount. How did the slave treat him?
- 5. How does this story relate to the fifth petition of the Lord's Prayer
