SCRATCH THE SURFACE

1. We are thinking about the sixth petition of the Lord’s Prayer tonight. What are the petitions we have already covered?
2. What is the sixth petition? What did the video say are the three sources that tempt us?
3. According to the video, why is temptation from the devil the most difficult?

Dig Deeper

1. The sixth petition asks delivery from temptation. Is God the one that tempts us?
2. Read the sixth petitions and what it means on page 25 of your Small Catechism or on your app. What are we praying for in the 6th petition?
3. What are the toughest temptations you think people in your school face? Think together of your top ten and rank from most tempting to the least. Your list might include things like; cheating, lying, drugs, alcohol, tobacco, stealing, bullying, popularity at the expense of others...
Why might you or someone else fall into these temptations? How might you avoid them?

Bible Story OF THE WEEK Temptation of Jesus Luke 4:1-13

1. Jesus is baptized and then the Holy Spirit leads him to a wilderness place. There, Jesus fasts for 40 days and nights. Famished, the devil tempts Jesus. What is Jesus tempted with?
2. Would any of these temptations be difficult for you? Why?
3. The devil tempts Jesus using scripture. Do you think people use scripture to tempt or mislead others?
4. Does Jesus take the devil's bait and fall into temptation?
5. What does this story tell us about temptation?

TAKING IT HOME

Pay attention to the times that you are tempted. Why is it hard to keep away from temptation? What makes it easier? Pray for God's guidance to lead you from that which turns you from God
