Bible Story OF THE WEEK Zacchaeus: Luke 19:1-10

1. As a chief tax collector, Zacchaeus was rich because people in his position would take more than people owed in taxes for themselves. How might this be thought of as evil?

2. What did Jesus do when he saw Zacchaeus in the tree? Is Jesus' response surprising? Why?

3. What changed Zacchaeus? How did Zacchaeus behave differently?

4. How would you react if you were Zaccheaus? The Crowd? Someone from the community hearing this story for the first time? (**affirm answers**)
